








The Nobel Prize in Chemistry Exhibition – A Report [18, Feb 2018]


The exhibition was located in a fascinating and attractive place the Dubai City Walk where we were inspired by the scientist Alfred Nobel's life, inventions and achievements.



What I have learnt from this exhibition is completely unforgettable, because it gave me and my colleagues a piece of hope to continue on our journey and never give up.




