To begin, we would like to express our heartfelt congratulations to Dr. Bazigha Abdul Rasool on one of her most recent and intriguing publications, "Optimizing and Evaluating the Transdermal Permeation of Hydrocortisone Transformers Formulation Based on Digital Analysis of In Vitro Drug Release and Ex Vivo Studies." Which can be found on the website of the National Library of Medicine.

It discusses the use of hydrocortisone (HC)-loaded Transferosomes to reach deep skin layers. Because HC is poorly absorbed through the skin, this study intends to demonstrate that modifying the route of administration can assist reduce negative effects while maintaining HC bioavailability.

This article is a study that shows how Upadacitinib (a medication that works by decreasing immune system activity and is classified as a "Janus Kinase (JAK) Inhibitor.") has proven to overcome cisplatin-induced renal toxicity and hepatotoxicity (Toxic Liver Disease) without affecting Cisplatin's anticancer activity (An anti-cancer drug used in chemotherapy).


















DOG TAG
